WARM WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS

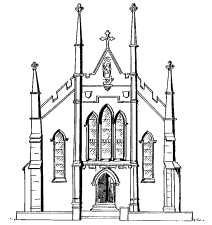

Almighty God, Your Word is cast like seed into the ground...

Today's Gospel reading contains the Parable of the Sower. God gives seeds to us; these seeds are His Word in its many expressions. He asks us to do something with these seeds. It is not enough just to hear the Word of God; we have to let it grow within us to such an extent that we bring forth good fruit for Him in our lives. It is not enough just to go to Church; we have to take our faith into the world with us. It is not enough to read the Bible; we have to become People of the Word.
