"Let us prepare our hearts...

The ancients believed that each person should be welcomed as though God Himself was being welcomed. Jesus encourages us to practise this virtue in today's Gospel. Hospitality is more than being a good host. It means encountering the presence of God in others, even in those whom we least expect it. We can be so self absorbed in our own expressions of spirituality, that we miss the presence of the Lord as He knocks on the door of our homes and on our lives through other people. The scribes and Pharisees were so self-absorbed that they missed God speaking through John the Baptist, calling him a fanatic; they missed God's presence in Jesus, saying He was just another person. Hospitality is the virtue of recognising the presence of God in others and nourishing His presence. When we practice it, the stranger is no longer a stranger, but a member of the family, and welcome, like Elisha, to enjoy a room in our home, our Church. Today we pray for an openness to God's presence in ways we least expect. We pray for the virtue of hospitality.
