FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT - 11th March 2018

Breathe on me, breath of God, fill me with life anew...

God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may is not be lost, but may have everlasting life (Jn 3:16), this is a frequently quoted verse from the Gospels.
