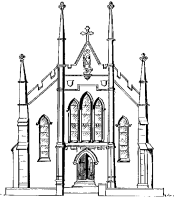

SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER – 13th May 2018

TODAY'S READINGS:

O Sacred Banquet, in which Christ is received...

Of the many types of sacrifices found in the Bible, one is particularly significant regarding Jesus' high-priestly prayer at the Last Supper. A person could offer an animal representing him or herself to God. The animal is burned to signify passage into the realm of the Holy. God accepts those making the sacrifice and invites them to share a sacrificial banquet as an expression of divine communion that has been given. The experience of communion with God is the reason that offering sacrifice of whatever kind in the bible is associated with joy. Today, hear the good news that our self-giving becomes one with the self-giving of Jesus. In the joy of this communion with the sacrifice of Christ, we offer our prayer of thanks and praise. We share the sacrificial banquet to which God invites us, receiving Jesus Himself as food and drink for eternal life. Then the Lord sends us into the world as he was sent to become bread and wine for others, so that all may rejoice in being one with Him in the life and love of God.
