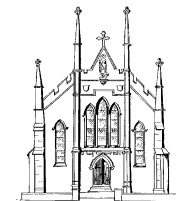

**E.U. G.D.P.R. (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION)** – this comes into effect on 25<sup>th</sup> May, and you will possibly have had letters and other communications from organizations who hold your personal data. Our parish is part of the Catholic Diocese of Lancaster, a charity recognised in the law of England and Wales; and it is the Diocese that is the 'data controller' for the purposes of the G.D.P.R. Please note that with the exception of the church registers and marriage records, we do not keep files on parishioners. Of course, we have parish records for Gift aid and offertory, and a list of sick parishioners who get Holy Communion at home. We also have some parishioners' telephone numbers, emails and home addresses. Some parishioners have also had DBS/CRB checks. There are also some historic parish census records from years gone by.

One of the important things about the GDPR is the control of the passing-on of data to third parties - as we have recently witnessed in the Facebook and Cambridge Analytica scandal. We do not pass on your details to third parties, nor in fact is such data generally held in an electronic format which would make such easy transmission possible.

### **TODAY'S READINGS:**

***Firmly I believe and truly God is Three, and God is One...***

Today we celebrate the intimate life of God. We celebrate the mystery of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and the eternal unity of God. We celebrate today the gift that we received at our baptism; at baptism we are brought into the intimate life of God, into the community of the Blessed Trinity. God's life flowed into us at our baptism. This life was not ours to hoard. God gives it to us to share with others, He asks us to lead others to accept and share in the intimacy He offers to us: *Baptise them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.* Jesus commands us, to provide the Life of the Trinity to all who will accept His Good News. Let's put ourselves on the hill in today's Gospel. We are there, basking in the love and joy of our Risen Saviour, it's as though He is saying to us: "Look at the Life I have given you, it is my life, the Divine Life of the Trinity. Give this Life to others. Proclaim my Gospel with your lives. And know that I will be with you through every situation, every choice, every rejection, every success."
