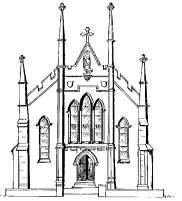
Evangelisation: Priests and their Pastoral Ministry.

TODAY'S READINGS:

Reach out and touch the Lord as He walks by...

From a busy crowd an unknown woman reaches out to touch Jesus' cloak. She plucks up the courage to get near this man, this healer, can He heal her? She reaches out, touches Him and she is instantly cured. Jesus was aware that power had gone out from Him. The woman, courageously, says it was her. Jesus tells her, *your faith has restored you to health* - she is free. There is an unfounded tradition, that this woman was Veronica, the woman who would later use her veil to wipe the face of Jesus as He makes His way to Calvary. On her veil was left the impression of Jesus' face. These incidents have a message for us. *Veronica*, means true image. The healing the woman receives deeply imprints *a true image* of Jesus in her heart. Jesus receives comfort from Veronica's act of charity and His true image is left on her veil – reflecting His image already planted in her heart. Our encounters with Jesus encourage us to go in peace and share His true image with our neighbours.
