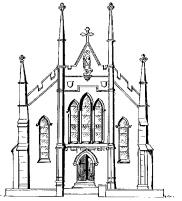

#### **TWENTY- SIXTH SUNDAY READINGS:**

***St Augustine was able to pray: "Late have I loved Thee..."***

We are blessed to be living in the age of the Holy Spirit. This wonderful age began at the first Pentecost when the Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit into the Church. The Holy Spirit is the living action of God. His presence is a transforming, renewing one. Given to us in Baptism and strengthened in us in Confirmation we are enabled to be God's instruments in the world today; we are empowered to bring spiritual change to the world. The Spirit is present where we least expect to find Him. No one can harness the Holy Spirit. He is God; He is the action of love that has been given to the world in the gift of the Father and the sacrifice of the Son.
