TODAY'S READINGS:

He made them male and female...

In the Catholic Church, marriage is a sacrament. A sacrament is a real presence of God, the most powerful presence of the Lord possible in this world. In the sacrament of Baptism, God is present giving the Life of the Trinity to the baptized. In Penance God is present through His Son giving His forgiveness to the penitent. In the Eucharist, the Son is present nourishing us and uniting us in an intimate way to the Divine Presence as Jesus is offered to the Father for us. In the sacrament of marriage, Jesus is present uniting His love to the love of the husband and wife. Their love, is His Love. The sacrament of marriage is not just a prayer during the wedding, it is not just a blessing of a union, it is far more than this. The sacrament of matrimony is the union of God with people establishing a new unit of His Church. The sacrament of matrimony establishes the Christian home with Christ at the centre.
