### **TODAY'S READINGS:**

***Go in peace...***

Our spiritual lives cannot and do not end when we leave Mass. We need to keep the fire of God's love burning through our daily prayer even if all we say is: *God loves me unconditionally, God forgives me, God is with me* - and then offer Him our day. Loving our neighbour as ourselves depends wholly on how we love ourselves. If our mind and heart are at war, then we are going to show our dissatisfaction with our lives to others. But if we are at one with ourselves and sincere in what we do, then we will be able to show others the respect, the love, we have for ourselves. As we encounter other people we must always try to recognise the presence of the Lord in them. Our peace comes from God's unconditional love for us; our peace is *made flesh* in the way we love and accept others. Serving them is serving God. Jesus gives us all we need and calls us to make Him present for others in the way we treat them. May the peace of Christ within us help us serve Him in others.
