### **READINGS FOR SEVENTH SUNDAY:**

***In Jesus' name I come to you...***

Is the Lord asking too much? Is he expecting too much of us? No, He is only telling us to be forgiving so we can receive forgiveness. In St Matthew's Gospel, the Jewish people are told to be sincere or perfect as their heavenly Father is sincere or perfect. In St Luke's Gospel, as we heard today, we are told to be compassionate as our Heavenly Father is compassionate. That word *compassionate* means to be concerned with human welfare and the alleviation of suffering by being charitable, sympathetic, and merciful. We all live under the mercy of God. We are all dependent on His care, His understanding. We are called to offer that care, that understanding in the most difficult of circumstance, to offer compassion to those who have hurt us in any way whatsoever. We are told: *Do not judge and you will not be judged yourselves, do not condemn and you will not be condemned yourselves, grant pardon and you will be pardoned, give and there will be gifts for you, a full measure, pressed down and running over.*
